#### **ABOUT THE EUROPEAN YOUTH LEAGUE**

In 2008 the former President of the European Shooting Confederation Unni Nicolaysen launched the idea of a special tournament for young athletes. The aim was to introduce the youths to international championships, especially the Youth Olympic Games, in a friendly atmosphere and in the spirit of fair play. There is no individual competition but a mixed team event for boys and girls in the age of 14 to 18 years. The first qualification of the EYL started in 2009 with the Final taking place in Denmark.

The 7th edition of the EYL is now close to its highlight. Young athletes from all over Europe have competed in three different steps. In January the first elimination competitions took place, followed by the qualification rounds in the 3 regions – North, West and East. From the regional competitions in Norway, Austria and Croatia the winning teams and the second placed teams qualified for the Final in Sweden. The host country always has the right to participate at the Final with one Rifle Team and one Pistol Team.

#### **Awards**

In addition to the EYL Medals the teams entering the podium will also get a special trophy from the host federation to keep as a nice souvenir. The ESC challenge trophies will be awarded to the best rifle and the best pistol teams for 1 year. The winning teams will also receive the special gifts from the ESC President Mr Vladimir Lisin in the form of 1-2-3 SIUS Hybridescore targets for the teams placing 3-2-1.


